Dear Mr. Bailey and Ms. Hanna,

This letter constitutes a formal complaint about the activities of a political committee currently involved in Glendale City elections. The committee is “No More Bad Deals for Glendale in Opposition to R-14-03 – Neighbors for a Better Glendale”.

The committee was initially registered 08/14/2014 (Exhibit A).

1. MISSING CAMPAIGN FINANCE REPORT

The Pre-Primary Election report for the period 06/14/2014 through 08/14/2014 was due by August 22, 2014 and has not been filed as of this writing. The report is at least 30 days late. Assuming there was no reportable financial activity on the day the committee was filed, they should have filed a “no activity” report.

A.R.S. § 16-918.B states the committee is “liable for a late penalty of ten dollars for each business day after failure to make or file a campaign finance report that is required pursuant to this chapter up to a maximum of four hundred fifty dollars.”

The minimum fine for the missing report should be \$300.00. Additional fines might accrue if the committee has been sent notification via certified mail there may be a failure to file a campaign report.

2. INCORRECT AND MISLEADING COMMITTEE FILING

Referendums are subjected to “strict compliance” in Arizona versus “substantial compliance” for initiatives. The principals filed their Statement of Organization stating the committee is in opposition to their own referendum. They are actually supporting their referendum.

Members of the general public that had an inkling to investigate the petition they were being asked to sign by paid circulators would assume that this committee was in opposition to the referendum based on both the name and the fact that the person completing the form CHECKED THE BOX indicating opposition to petition serial number R-14-03. That completed form was signed by committee Chairman Gary Hirsch and committee Treasurer Jill Ryan.

To the general public, it would also appear that the sponsoring organization (Neighbors for a Better Glendale) is opposing the referendum. Since, to the best of my knowledge, the sole sponsoring organization for Neighbors for a Better Glendale is the Gila River Indian Community, the public would be led to believe the Community is also in opposition to the referendum.

None of the three organizations mentioned above oppose R-14-03, the committee name is misleading and the selection of the “oppose” checkbox on the committee statement of organization is erroneous.

The same principals are involved in another committee that has the *exact same* error.

Had the committee been formed and then run by “amateurs” with no political experience, such a gaffe could perhaps be excused. In this case, the parties involved are anything but inexperienced in local politics. According to the finance reports filed, this committee has spent many thousands of dollars hiring professional political people who have been involved in many other referendum and initiative attempts. It’s hard to believe professionals would make ANY mistakes in simple paperwork, so the misleading filing could logically be assumed to be purposeful.

I believe any business, including circulating petitions for signatures, performed by this committee or in their behalf should be voided. The rules are there for a reason, and completing forms correctly counts.

3. COMMITTEE ID INCORRECT ON CAMPAIGN FINANCE REPORTS

The committee id number on pages two and four of the Post-Primary finance report is incorrect.

4. MISSING NOTICES OF CONTRIBUTIONS

Contributions:

1. 09/26/2014 Post-Primary finance report (exhibit B)
 - a. \$35,000 – 08/29/2014 – from “Neighbors for a Better Glendale”
 - b. \$10,000 – 09/09/2014 – from “Neighbors for a Better Glendale”
 - c. \$10,000 – 09/12/2014 – from “Neighbors for a Better Glendale”

A.R.S. § 16-914.01 (B) (1) states that contributions of more than ten thousand dollars from a single source must be reported.

A.R.S. § 16-914.01 (C) states that said notice must be filed within twenty-four hours excluding Saturdays, Sundays and other legal holidays. Clearly, that has not been done, although another committee in Glendale (Protect Glendale Taxpayers) filed their notices in a timely fashion.

A.R.S. § 16-914.01 (D) states a political committee that violates the section are liable in a civil action for a civil penalty of up to three times the amount improperly reported as prescribed by A.R.S. § 16-924.

In this case, no notices have been filed by the “No More Bad Deals” committee. The committee has three contributions totaling \$55,000 that should have been reported to the City of Glendale within 24 hours.

The purpose of these statutes is to prevent a committee “flying under the radar”. Had this committee waited one day (until August 15) to register their committee, they could have legally completed their petition circulation with NO PUBLIC NOTICE WHATSOEVER. Because referendum signatures must be gathered within 30 days of the legislative action to which it refers, there would have been no campaign finance report due until September 25, well AFTER the petition signatures were due. There is no announcement of committee registrations, one is required to submit an information request to receive that information. Without “inside knowledge” or something silly like a participant publishing images on social media, one would not see the need to file such a request.

In this case, I believe the potential civil penalty for this infraction is three times the amount improperly reported, or \$165,000.

5. MISSING NOTICES OF EXPENDITURES

1. 09/26/2014 Post-Primary finance report (exhibit B)
 - a. \$30,000.00 – 08/19/2014 – to “Petition Partners”
 - b. \$10,000.00 – 09/11/2014 – to “Petition Partners”
 - c. \$7,053.80 – 09/12/2014 – to “Petition Partners”

A.R.S. § 16-914.01 (B) (2) states that expenditures of more than ten thousand dollars must be reported.

A.R.S. § 16-914.01 (C) states that said notice must be filed within twenty-four hours excluding Saturdays, Sundays and other legal holidays. Again, as with the contributions, there have been no notices filed by this committee other than the standard campaign finance reports. Another well monetized committee in Glendale (Protect Glendale Taxpayers) filed their notices in a timely fashion.

A.R.S. § 16-914.01 (D) states a political committee that violates the section are liable in a civil action for a civil penalty of up to three times the amount improperly reported as prescribed by A.R.S. § 16-924.

This committee has spent \$40,000 (two transactions) that should have been reported.

In this case, I believe the potential civil penalty for this infraction is three times the amount improperly reported, or \$120,000.

6. MISSING MONEY

The Post-Primary campaign finance report filed by “Neighbors for a Better Glendale” (Exhibit C) lists a \$30,000 contribution to this committee on 08/29/2014. This committee reports they actually received \$35,000 on that date from “Neighbors for a Better Glendale”.

If the amount received was \$35,000, where did the other \$5,000 originate? It should be harder to accept an answer provided as “a simple bookkeeping mistake” because the same person (Jill Ryan) signed BOTH reports as the Treasurer of both committees on the same day.

CONCLUSION

No actions performed by this committee should be valid because their committee name and opposition statement on their statement of organization filed with the City of Glendale is incorrect.

The total of civil fines for not reporting donations and expenditures this committee should be liable for is \$285,000.

DEFINITION OF POLITICAL COMMITTEE: A.R.S. § 16-901(19) "Political committee" means a candidate or any association or combination of persons that is organized, conducted or combined for the purpose of influencing the result of any election or to determine whether an individual will become a candidate for election in this state or in any county, city, town, district or precinct in this state, that engages in political activity in behalf of or against a candidate for election or retention or in support of or opposition to an initiative, referendum or recall or any other measure or proposition and that applies for a serial number and circulates petitions and, in the case of a candidate for public office except those exempt pursuant to section 16-903, that receives contributions or makes expenditures of more than two hundred fifty dollars in connection therewith, notwithstanding that the association or combination of persons may be part of a larger association, combination of persons or sponsoring organization not primarily organized, conducted or combined for the purpose of influencing the result of any election in this state or in any county, city, town or precinct in this state" Examples of types of political committees are listed on the front of this form.

NOTE FOR INDIVIDUALS INVOLVED IN POLITICAL ACTIVITIES: An individual acting alone, unless that individual is a candidate, is not a political committee under Arizona law and need not file a statement of organization. If any additional person or persons join the effort (as defined above in A.R.S. § 16-901(19)) begun by an individual, the association of persons has become a "political committee" under Arizona law, and must register the committee pursuant to A.R.S. § 16-902.01(A).

NOTE FOR THOSE INVOLVED IN INITIATIVE, REFERENDUM AND RECALL EFFORTS: Before circulating initiative, referendum or recall petitions, a political committee must file its statement of organization with the appropriate filing office. Signatures obtained on petitions prior to the filing of the statement of organization are void and shall not be counted in determining the legal sufficiency of the petition. A.R.S. §§ 19-114(B) and 19-202(C). Even though an individual, acting alone, may begin the initiative, referendum or recall effort, as soon as other persons join the effort, the association of persons must register as a political committee.
